Additional information:

If the <u>mean value</u> of the progress tests is \geq 4,5 (over 10,0), assignments will be taken into account having a weighting of 10 % of the final mark (90 % mean value PTs + 10 % assignment). Otherwise, the final mark will be the mean value of the progress tests (100% mean value PTs). A mark lower to 3,0 for any of the progress tests means suspense for the subject and the final mark will be the lowest mark between the two progress tests. Assignments won't be applied for each PT but at the end of the subject.

The subject will be passed whenever the final mark (90% mean value PTs + 10% Assignments) is \geq 4,95 (over 10,0).

Students of other promotions have weighting of 100% for PTs but there is the option to attend classes as a normal student with all weightings.

Students who couldn't attend a sitting due to a *justifiable cause* have the option to present at the end of the subject a recuperative for each progress.

In the RE-SIT exam, the weighting of assignments will be maintained. Weightings in the cases of marks 4,5 and 4,95 are applied for the RE-SIT exam.

Missing a third part or more of the sessions that comprise the subject will mean suspense regardless of the mark obtained.
