## Additional information:

The notes of the Worksheets (20% worksheets+80% PT) will only be considered if the student obtains a mark greater or equal to 4 in the corresponding progress test. If the student does not reach that limit, the weighting will be 100% for the PT. A mark lower than 3,0 in any of the progress tests means that the subject is FAILED and the final mark will be the lowest mark of the two progress tests.

The subject will be passed whenever the final mark resulting from averaging the results of the 2 progress tests and their corresponding worksheets (see above) is  $\geq$  4,95 (over 10).

Normas Académicas y Disciplinarias Grado Universitario (page 17, 9th edition June 2023)

Students who cannot attend a progress test sitting due to a <u>justifiable cause</u> have the option to a re-sit at the end of the subject for each progress test. In the re-sit exam, the weighting of the different aspects will be maintained.

For grade repeating students (i.e: not taking the subject for the first time), the exams (either progress tests or final exam) will represent 100 % of the final mark.

Missing **one third or more** of the sessions that comprise the subject will mean that the subject is FAILED regardless of the grade obtained in the tests.

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
