<p>Additional information:</p> <p><i>The notes of the Worksheets (20% worksheets+80% PT) will only be considered if the student obtains a mark greater or equal to 4 in the corresponding progress test. If the student does not reach that limit, the weighting will be 100% for the PT. A mark lower than 3,0 in any of the progress tests means that the subject is FAILED and the final mark will be the lowest mark of the two progress tests.</i></p> <p><i>The subject will be passed whenever the final mark resulting from averaging the results of the 2 progress tests and their corresponding worksheets (see above) is $\geq 4,95$ (over 10).</i></p> <p><i>Normas Académicas y Disciplinarias Grado Universitario (page 17, 9th edition June 2023)</i></p> <p><i>Students who cannot attend a progress test sitting due to a <u>justifiable cause</u> have the option to a re-sit at the end of the subject for each progress test.
